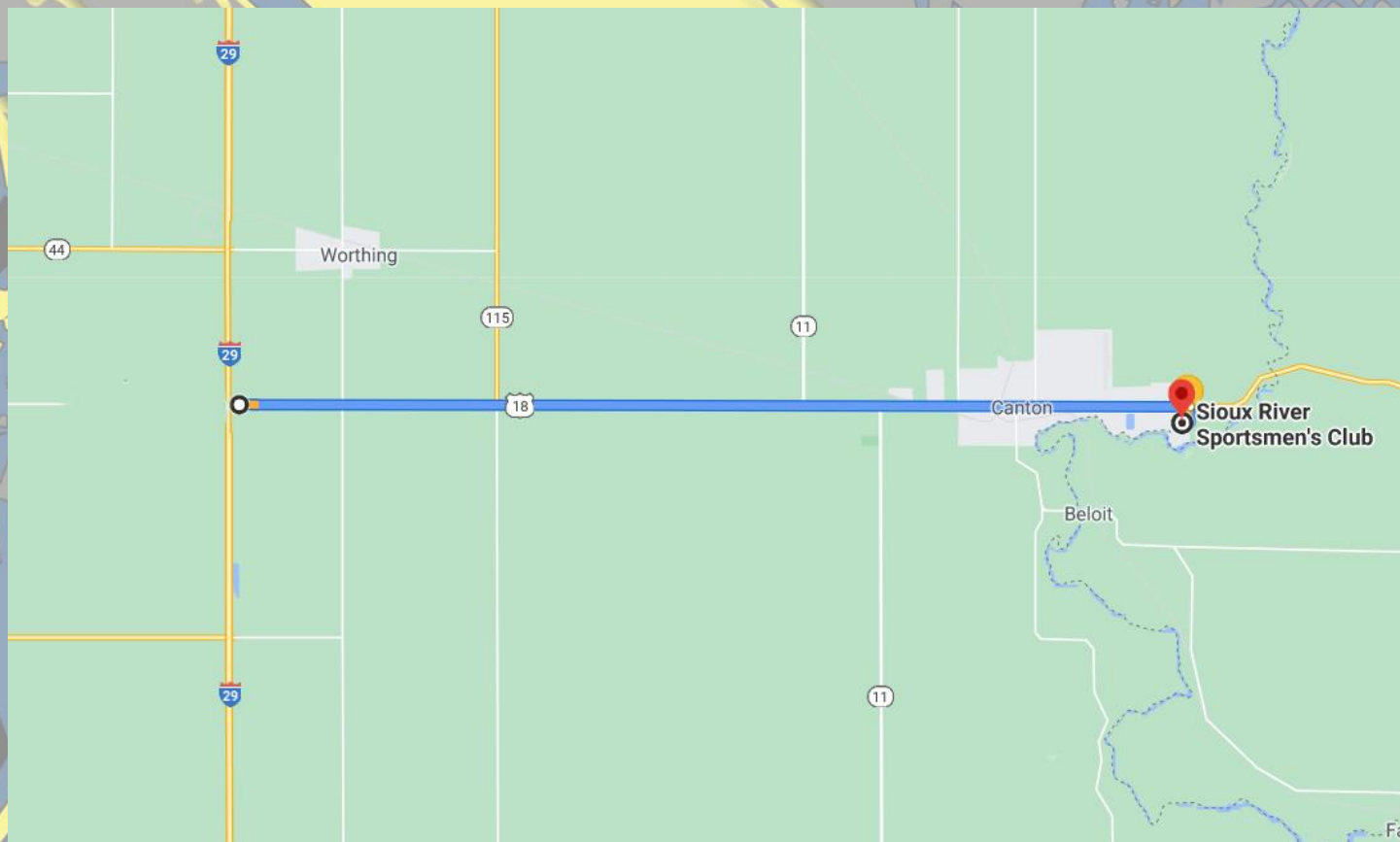

Check In

You will check in at your first stage of the match. Your information will be verified at that time. Report to your first stage by 7:30am. Any discrepancies and changes will be fixed at that time. If you wish to change divisions we will accommodate that on match day, but please change it on your registration in advance if possible. If you ordered a shirt you will get it at that time as well.

Scoring

Scoring will be done through Practiscore. We will be using paperless scoring. There will NOT be a chronograph at the match.

Squadding

We will lock squadding on Wednesday June 3. If you want to switch squads please do so before then. If we need to move people around for match management purposes we will. We will do our best to accommodate any requests late but won't make any guarantees.

Water on the Bays

There will be plenty of water on the bays and it will be kept cold to the best of our ability.

Lost Brass Match

This is a lost brass match. Staff will be given the brass from their stages if they choose.

Safety Areas

There will be safety tables set up all over the range. The range will be cold, do not handle guns in the parking area. Only handle them in the safe areas.

Eye and Ear Protection

Eye and ear protection are required for all competitors. Eye protection is required to be worn by all spectators. Anyone under the age of 18 is required to use ear and eye protection at all times in accordance with club rules.

Stages

The stage designs provided in the matchbook will be mostly accurate. They may be different once they get on the ground.

Stages may be walked on Friday until the range closes at 7pm. They may also be walked during the staff shoot on Saturday as long as they are unoccupied. Do not touch any activators or moving targets during walkthroughs. The range will close at 7pm on Saturday night.

Driving to Range

Be careful driving on US-18 from I-29 to Canton. Don't speed, many shooters in previous years have gotten tickets.

Stages may be walked when a squad is not present. Do not activate any props. The range will be open until 7pm each day for walk throughs.

Targets: 12 USPSA target(s), 2 steel

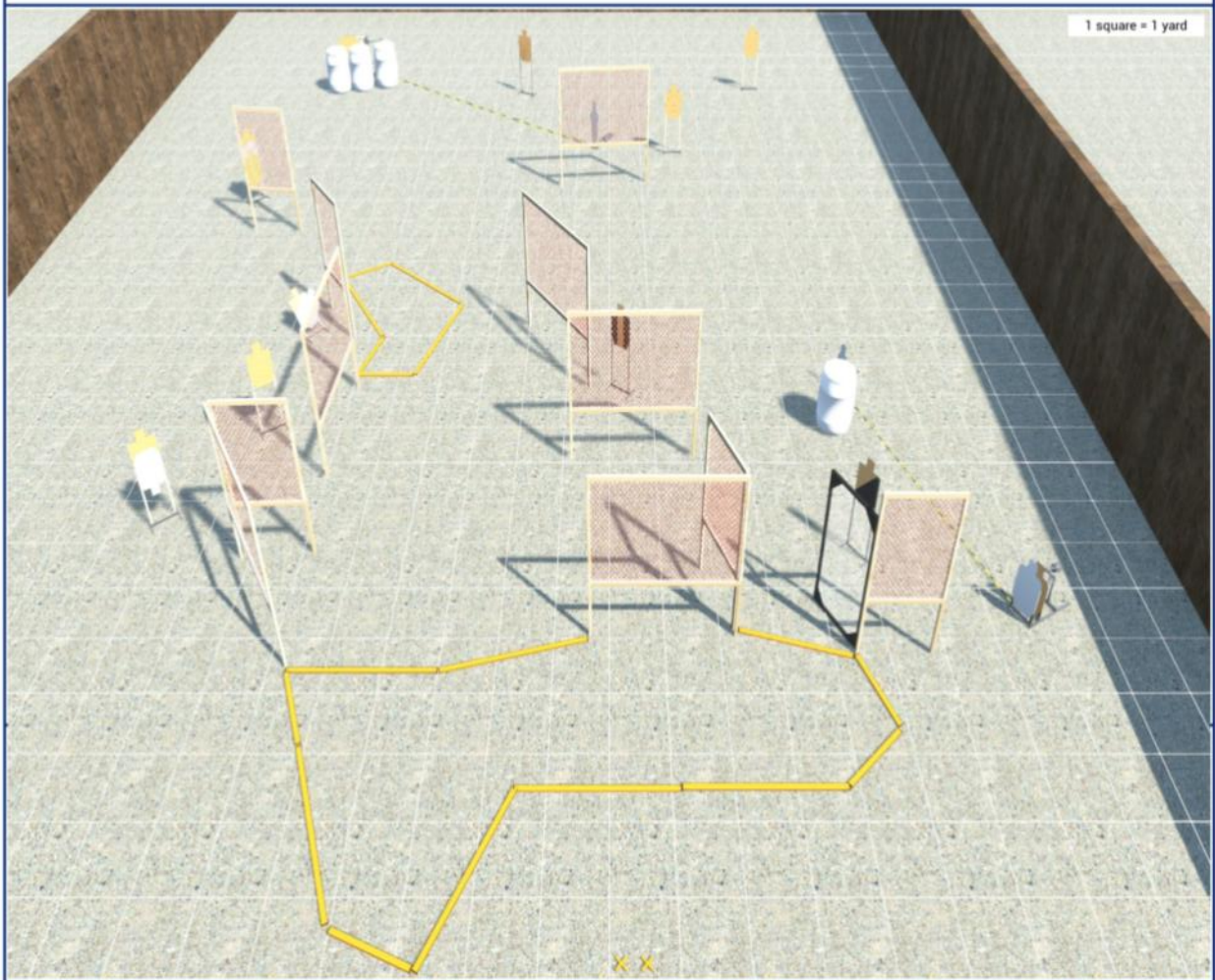
Rounds: 26

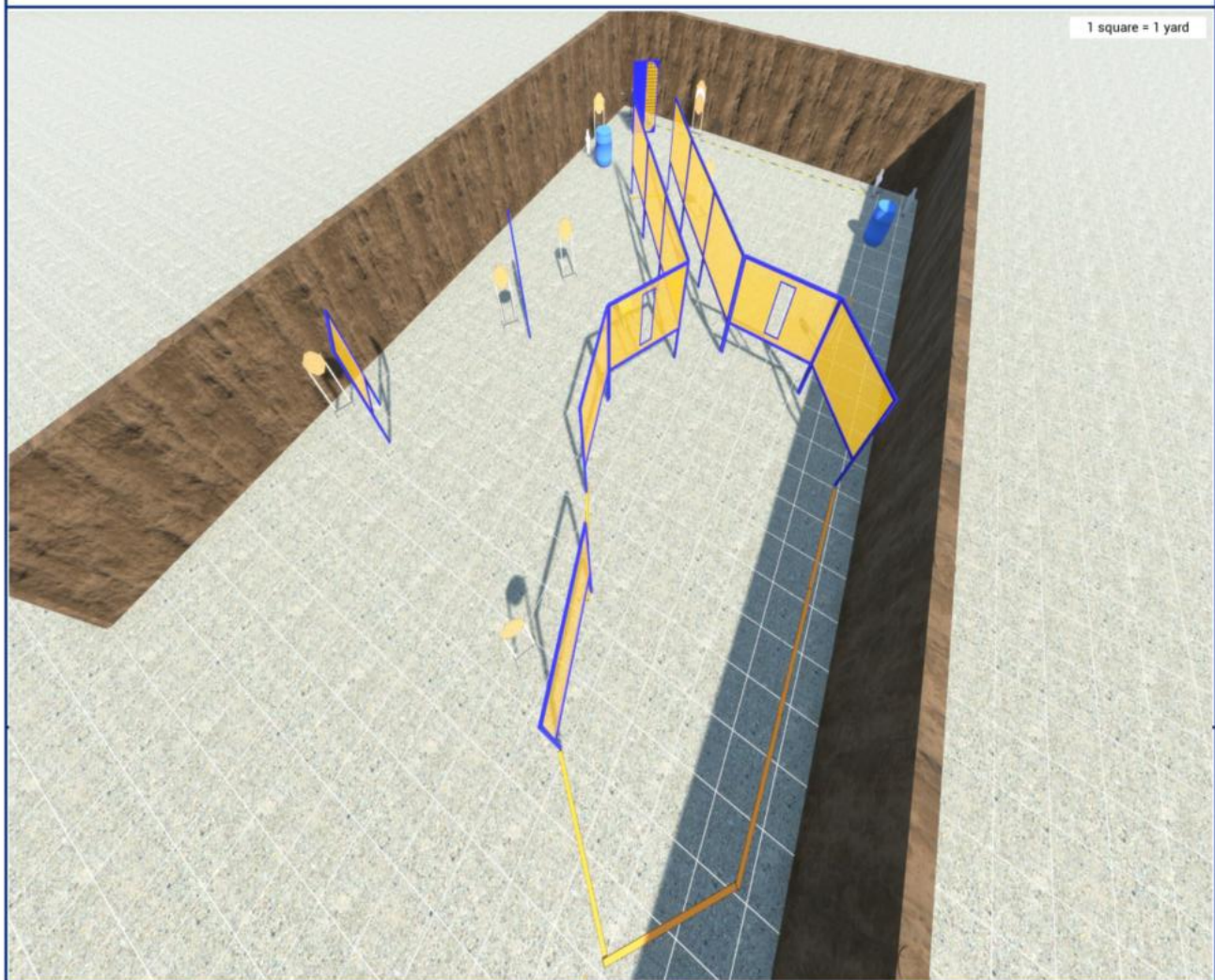

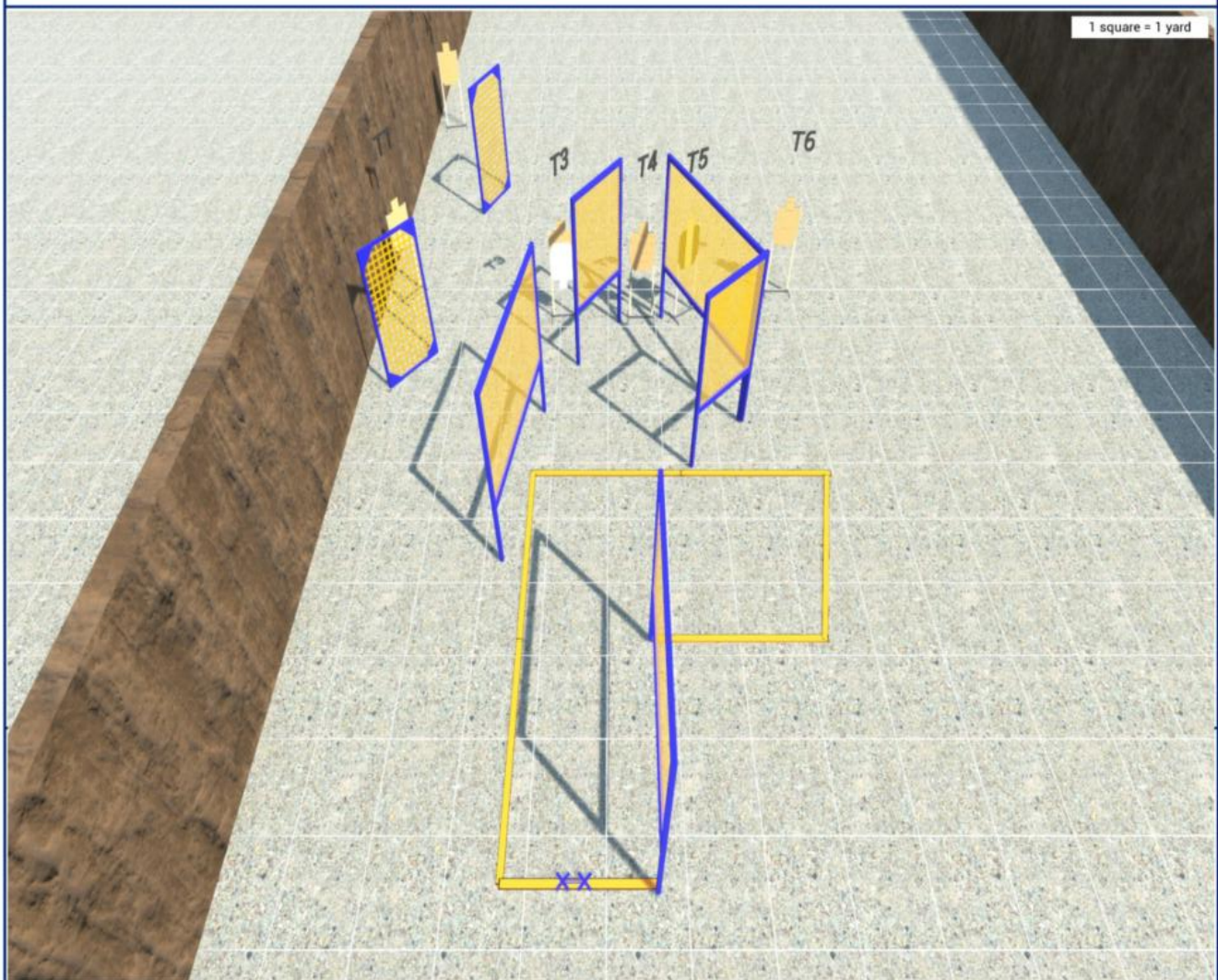

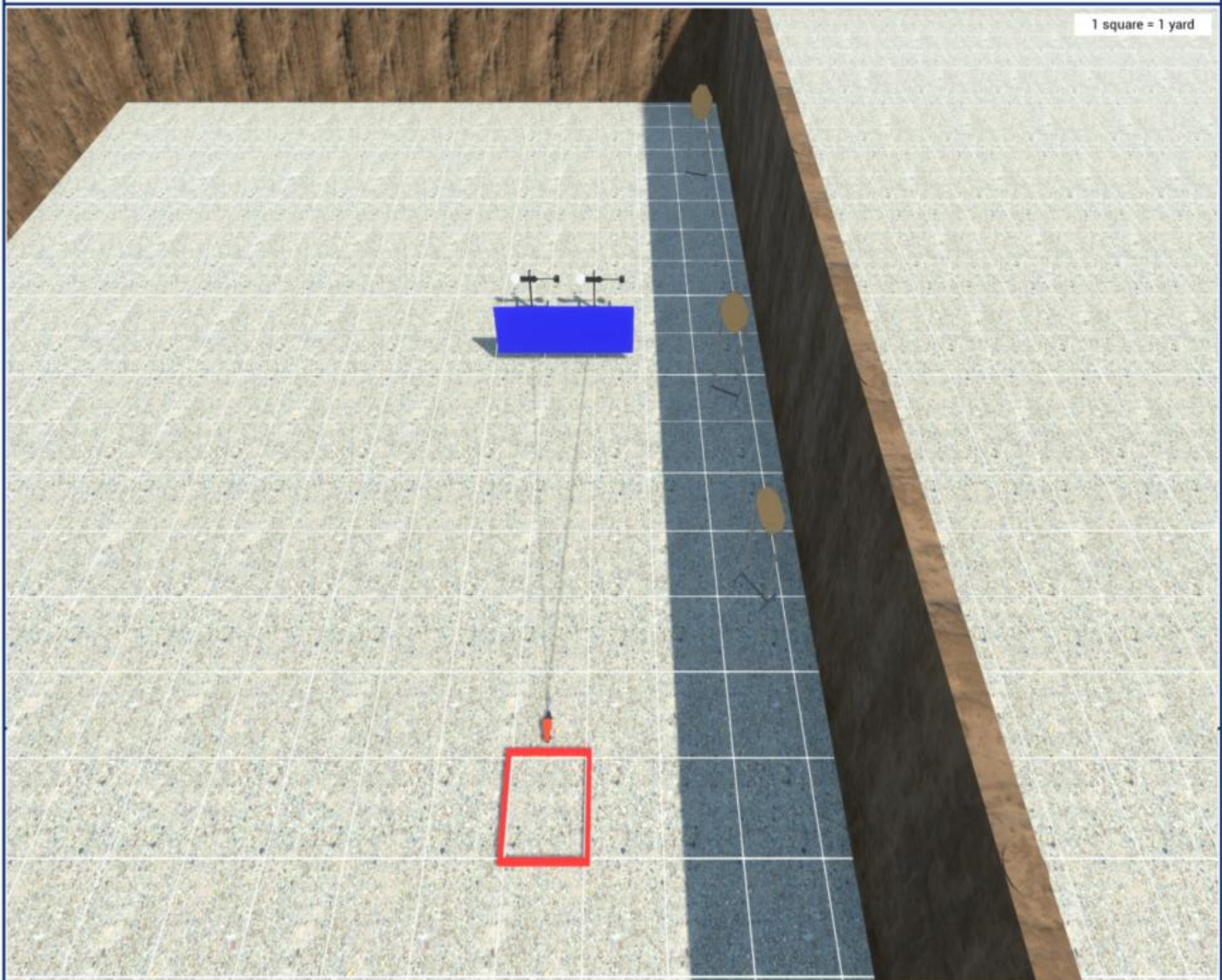

Targets: 7 USPSA target(s), 2 steel

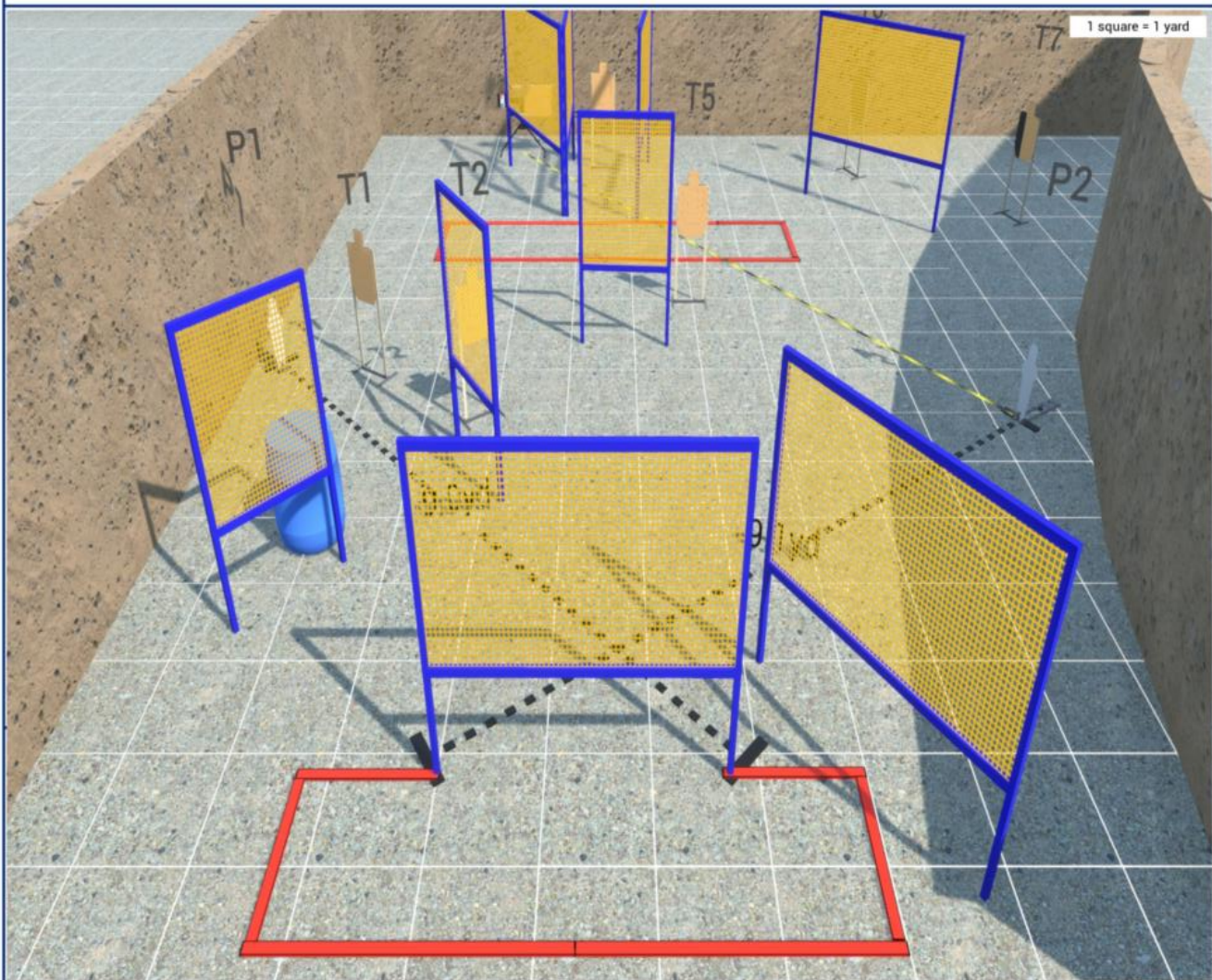
Rounds: 23

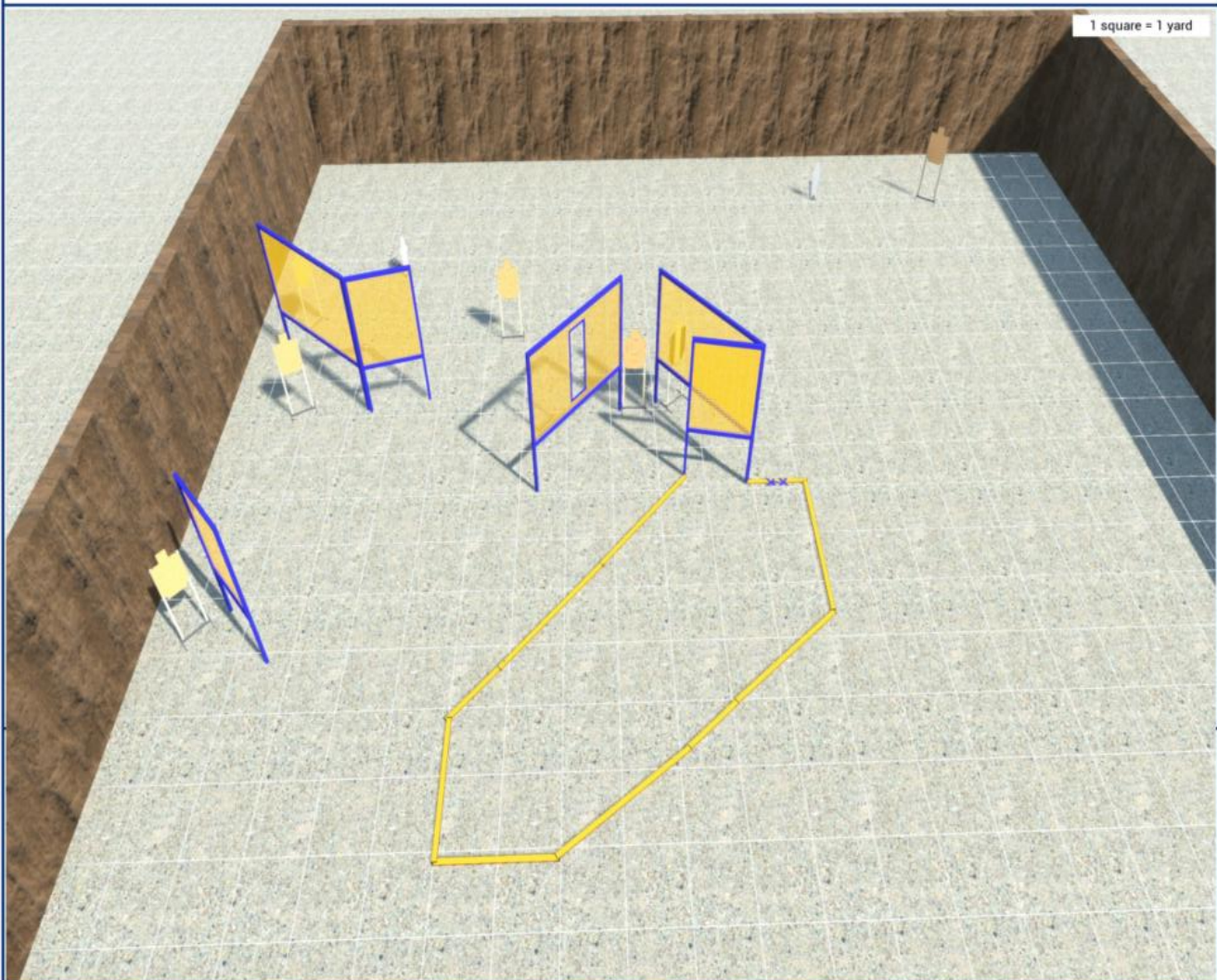

Targets: 10 IPSC target(s), 4 steel

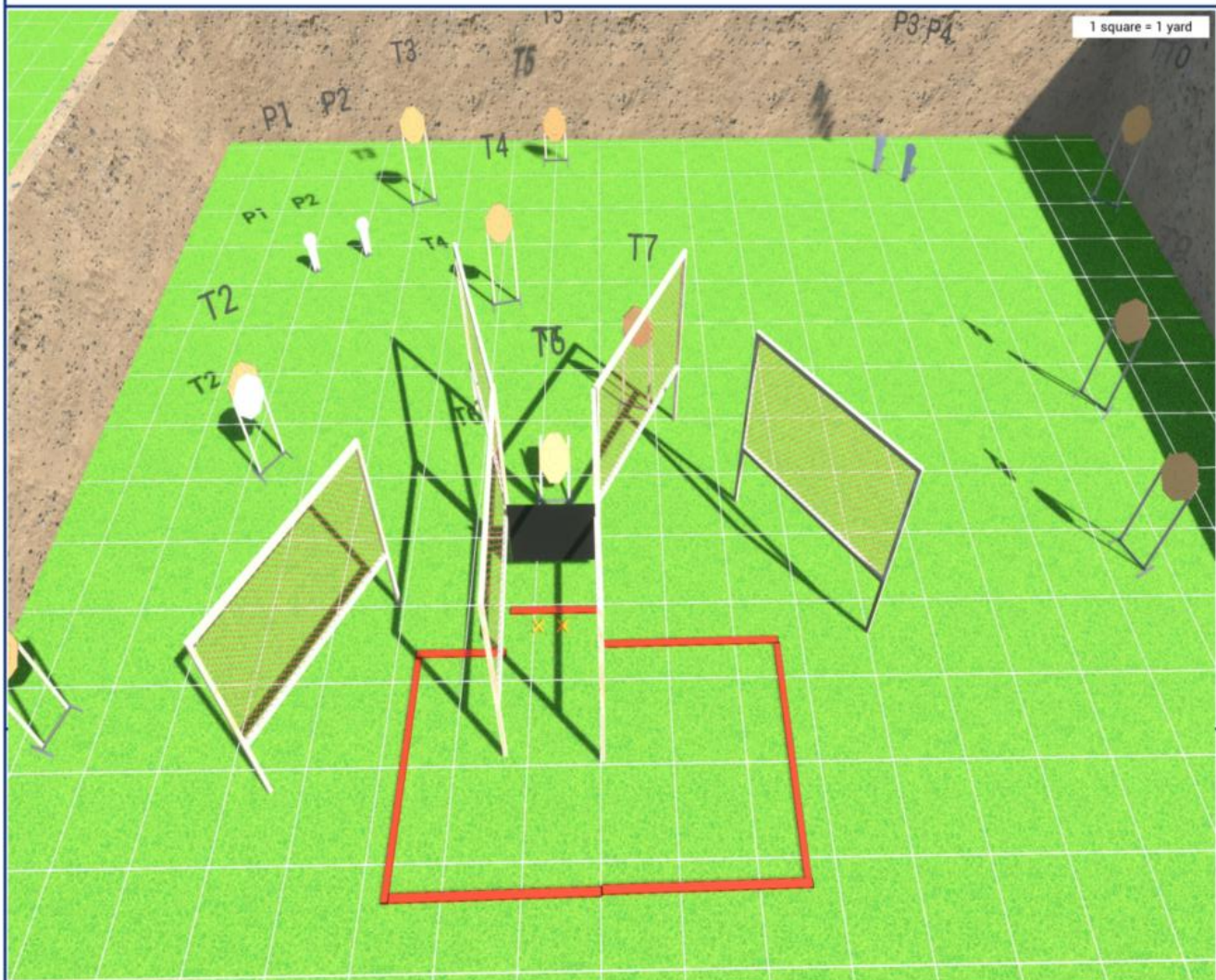

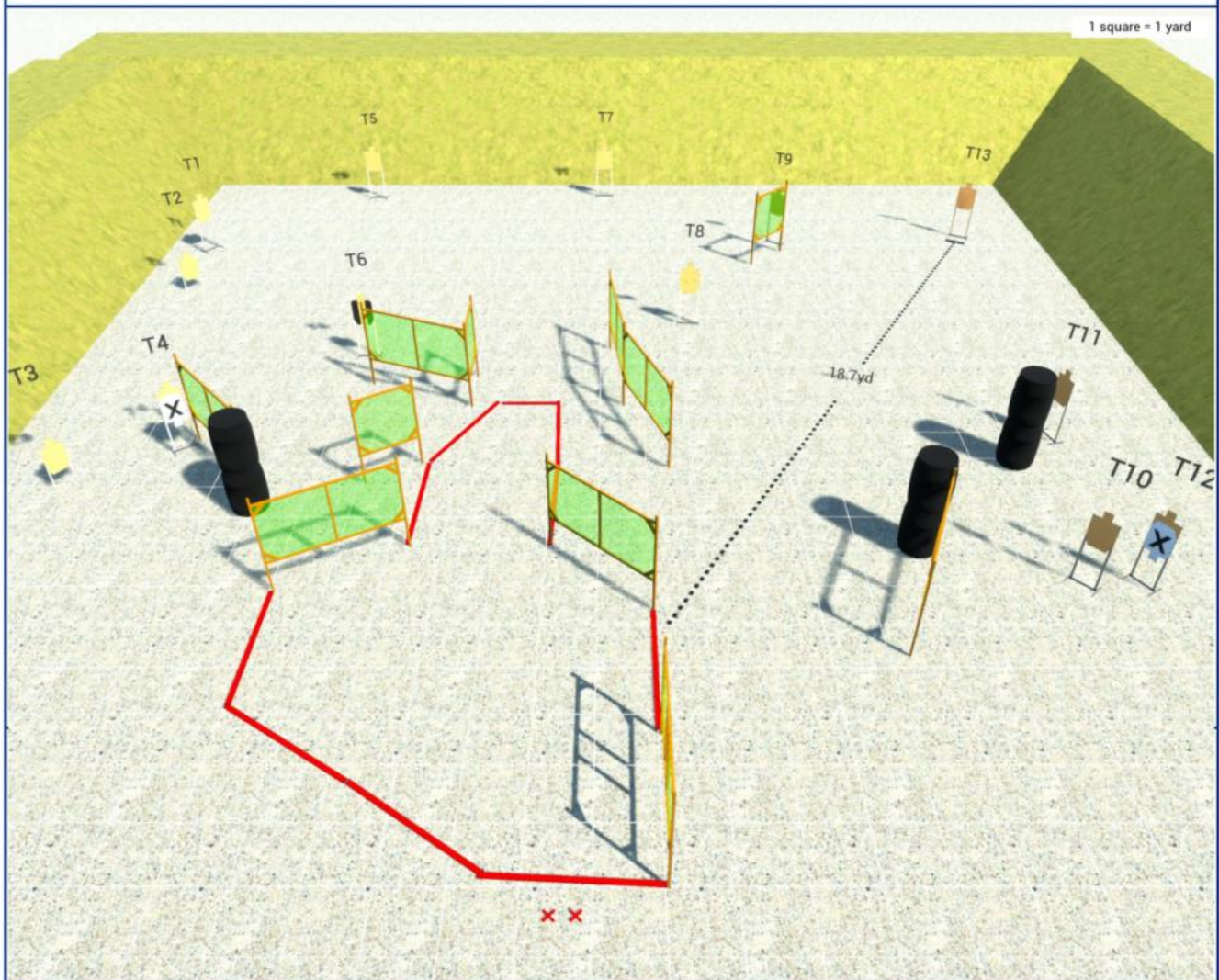

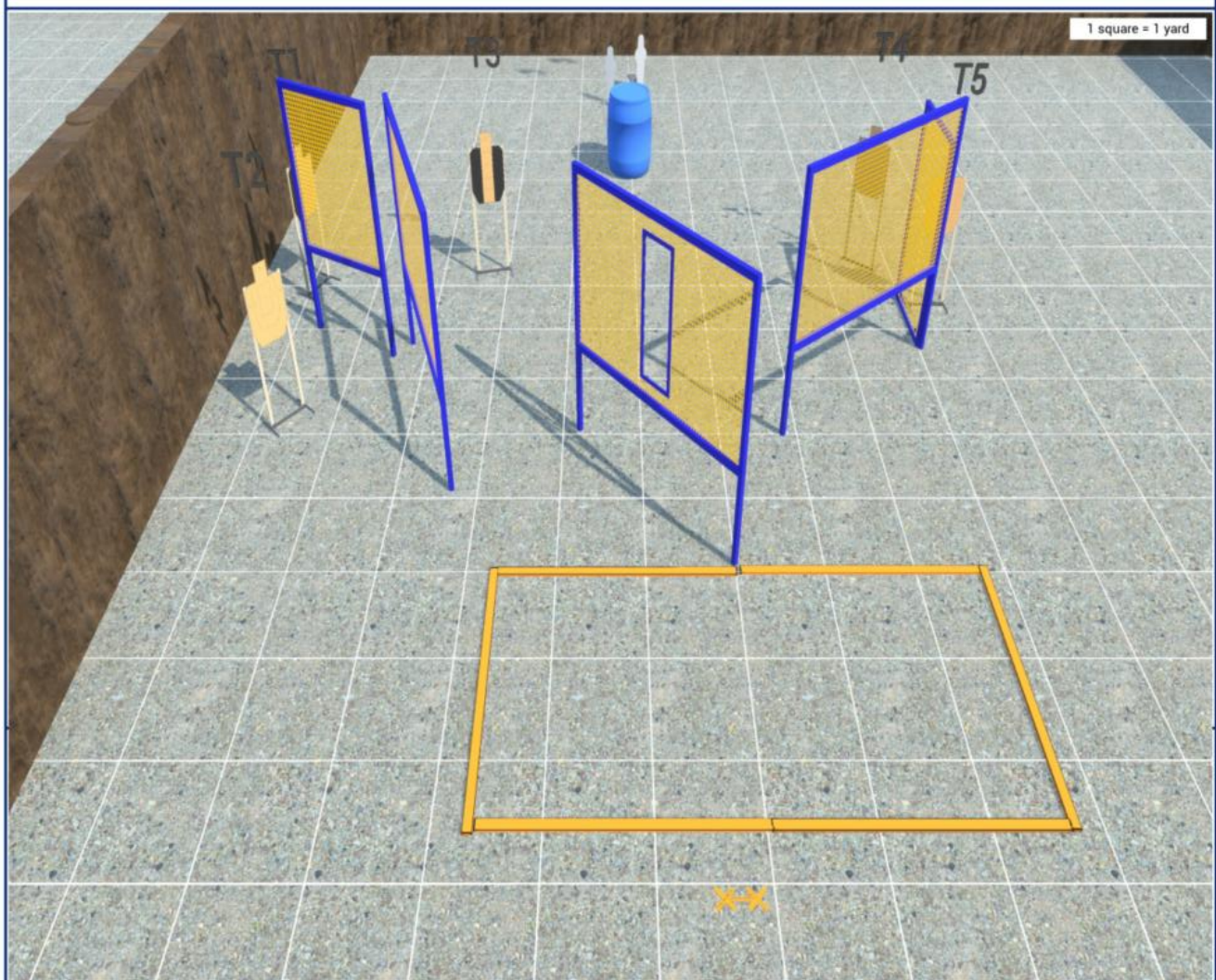

Targets: 4 IPSC target(s), 0 steel

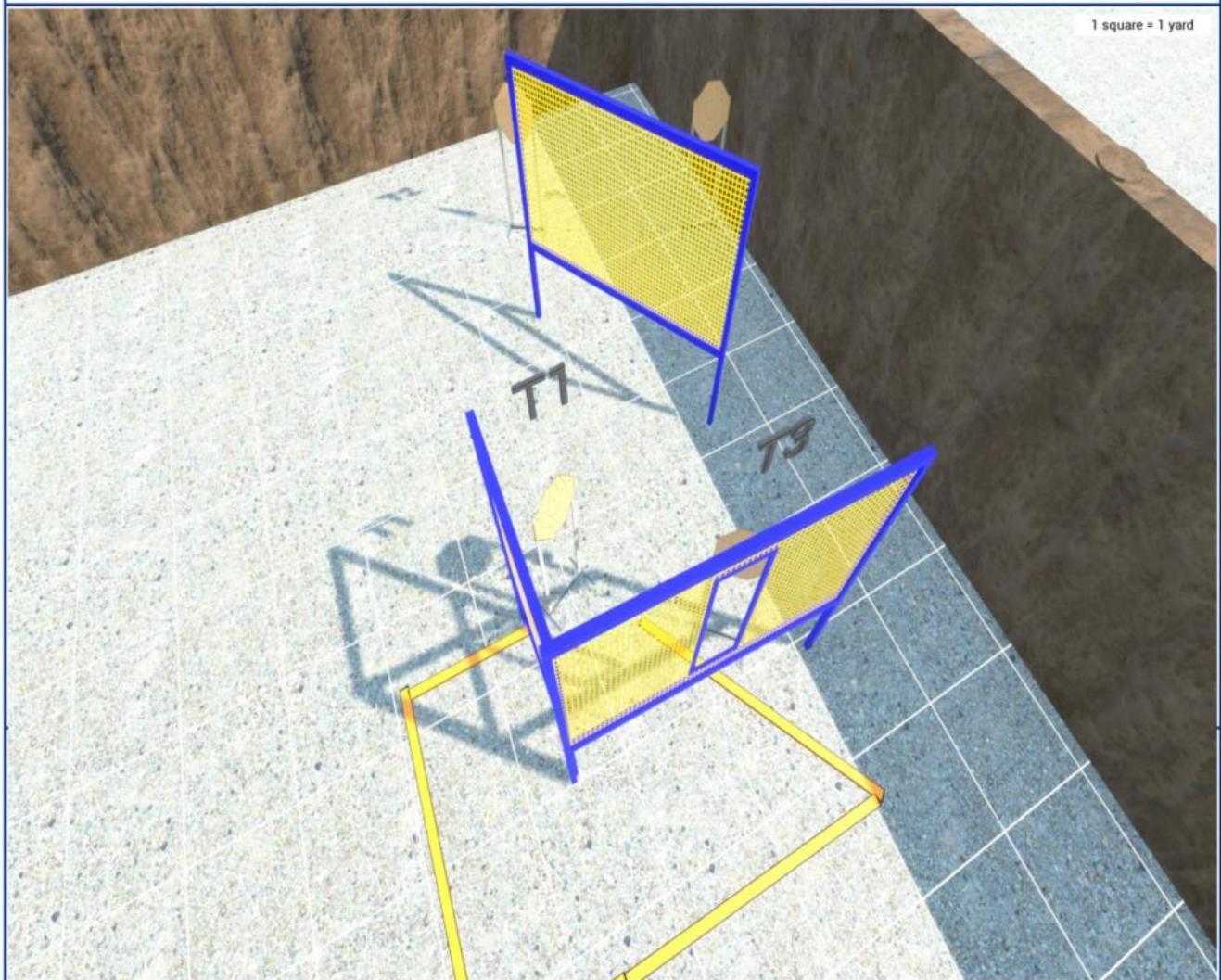
Rounds: 8
